




What the indigenous peasant organization and the organization of TBA contribute is a resistance to modernity "as a civilizing tendency endowed with a new unitary principle of coherence or structuring for civilized social life and for the world corresponding to that life", a resistance to the obsolescence of the ancestral (**Echeverría** 2009, 7-8).

This resistance is based on the ability to **approach nature in sacred and not purely profane mathematized terms**, giving meaning to the construction of other modes of health.
